I responded to the area of Paper Mill Road and Byberry Road for a parking complaint involving numerous vehicles parked on both sides of the road making it difficult for cars to drive through. Upon My arrival, I found numerous vehicles parked on the roadway partially blocking traffic. I parked near 3325 Paper Mill Road and when I exited my car I heard voices coming from the bushes in front of 3271 Paper Mill Road. I found 6 juvenile females hiding in the bushes and they reported they were at a party and heard the police were coming so they ran from the house and hid in the bushes. They stated the underage drinking party was two doors away and the party was thrown by [JUVENILE#22]. I brought them to 3325 Paper Mill Road and knocked on the front door. I heard scurrying in the home and after a couple minutes, an adult female opened the door. She identified herself as [JUVENILE#22 PARENT], the home owner. She reported her son [JUVENILE #22] was having a birthday party while she and her husband were upstairs. She did not know that alcohol was being consumed by the teenagers. She allowed me to look through the first floor and basement of the home. In the kitchen and dining room I observed several opened cans of "Natural Light" along with plastic solo cups and plastic shot glasses. while looking through the basement, I found numerous male and female teenagers. They were all brought to the first floor where they were identified. While I was dealing with the teenagers inside the home, Sergeant Scirrotto and Officer Gaffney found numerous females outside the home, identified them and kept them at the front of the house. All of the subjects are identified on a supplemental report along with their PBT readings and to whom they were released. All of the parents of the teenagers either came to pick up their child or allowed them to be driven home by another parent. Underage Drinking citations will be sent to those with PBT readings above .000.
